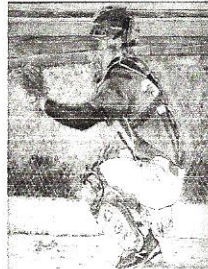

Manitoba Baseball Hall of Fame and Museum Heritage Trust Program Stretches Gift Dollars

The Manitoba Baseball Hall of Fame and Museum is fortunate to be able to partner with the Manitoba Heritage Trust Program (MHTP) through the Winnipeg Foundation.

The Manitoba Baseball Hall of Fame and Museum is vital in fostering the development of baseball in Manitoba by recording the achievements and permanently recording history by celebrating the attainments of their best teams, players, sport builders, umpires, and media personnel.

The Winnipeg Foundation is Canada's first community foundation with a mandate of strengthening philanthropy throughout Manitoba by providing supports and services to employ and build capacity among Manitoba's community foundations. The Province of Manitoba has allocated \$5 million in stretch dollar for the MHTP to distribute from April 1, 2018 to March 31, 2021.

All guaranteed eligible gifts to a heritage fund amounting up to \$50,000, will be stretched by the MHTP. For every two dollars given to the fund, the program will stretch the gift with an additional one dollar with a maximum of \$25,000 in a stretch per organization. This means a gift of two dollars becomes three dollars.

If there is any remaining in the MHTP after all the heritage funds have received their guaranteed stretch, there is the potential of an additional stretch and a potential bonus stretch.

The Manitoba Heritage Trust Program, which is administered by the Winnipeg Foundation will run until March 31, 2021, offers qualifying museums, and archives the opportunity to build up an endowment fund to support their organization.

The deadline for contributions is on the horizon. Enhance your contributions by completing the gift form below. A charitable tax receipt will be issued.
